

Figure S1. Direct Oral Anticoagulants (DOACs) dosing and reduction criteria

DOAC	Standard Daily Dose	Reduced Daily Dose	Criteria for Dose Reduction
Apixaban	5 mg twice daily (BID)	2.5 mg BID	Must meet at least two of the three criteria: age > 80 years, body weight < 60 kg, creatinine (Cr) > 1.5 mg/dL
Dabigatran	150 mg BID	110 mg BID	CrCl: 30–50 mL/min, OR Age >80 years
Rivaroxaban	20 mg once daily (QD)	15 mg QD	CrCl: 15–49 mL/min
Edoxaban	60 mg QD	30 mg QD	Must meet at least one of these criteria: CrCl: 15–50 mL/min, Body weight < 60 kg, OR concomitant use of potent P-glycoprotein inhibitors

Hypertension	+1
Prior stroke, TIA, or Thromboembolism	+2
Vascular disease	+1
Diabetes	+1
