The antibody anti-TRPV1 showed a double band between 80 and 100 Kda (the theoretical molecular weight of the TRPV1 is 94 kDa). The antibody anti-PPARγ showed a single band of ~ 50 kDa (the theoretical molecular weight of PPARγ is 57 kDa). The antibody anti-GPR3 showed a major band at ~ 40 kDa (theoretical molecular weight of GPR3 is 42 kDa). The numbers on the spinal cord, jejunum and colon lines indicate the molecular weights. The images of the immunoblots were slightly adjusted in brightness and contrast to match their backgrounds. Of note, the total amount of protein was not normalised among tissues.
